

**Abstract of Section 33E(1) of Merchant Shipping (Local Vessels) (General)
Regulation (Cap.548F)**

33E. Application of Division 3

- (1) This Division applies to a Class I vessel that is licensed to carry more than 12 passengers except—
- (a) a floating restaurant;
 - (b) a stationary vessel;
 - (c) a vessel to which Part 9 applies; or
 - (d) a vessel the operating licence of which restricts the vessel to plying within a typhoon shelter.

[To be added on 1 January 2022:

- (1A) This Division also applies to—
- (a) a Class IV vessel that is licensed to carry 13 to 60 passengers and is let for hire or reward; and
 - (b) a Class IV vessel that is licensed to carry more than 60 passengers.]

(Sections 33E to 33I stipulate the requirements related to VHF radiotelephone.)

**Abstract of Section 80B(1) of Merchant Shipping (Local Vessels) (Safety and
Survey) Regulation (Cap.548G)**

80B. Radiotelephone equipment

- (1) This section applies to a Class I vessel that is licensed to carry more than 12 passengers except—
- (a) a floating restaurant;
 - (b) a stationary vessel;
 - (c) a vessel to which Part 9 of the Merchant Shipping (Local Vessels) (General) Regulation (Cap. 548 sub. leg. F) applies; or
 - (d) a vessel the operating licence of which restricts the vessel to plying within a typhoon shelter.

[To be added on 1 January 2022:

- (1A) This section also applies to—
- (a) a Class IV vessel that is licensed to carry 13 to 60 passengers and is let for hire or reward; and
 - (b) a Class IV vessel that is licensed to carry more than 60 passengers.]

(Section 80B stipulates the requirements related to radiotelephone equipment.)
